Dear Members,

We have assessed Governor Wolf's health announcement of December 10, 2020, and have made a decision to keep our facility operating. The restrictions are aimed at high-risk activities where the virus has been known to spread. Since reopening in June 2020, we have had over 5,000 check-ins and thankfully, no reported cases of COVID-19.

We realize some members may not be comfortable playing in the current condition. We fully respect this position and encourage you to contact us to discuss how we can accommodate your specific needs.

For those of you who will continue to play, we need you to strictly comply with the following protocol:

BEFORE PLAYING

- **Do not enter the facility before your designated playing time.** The club house will not be open for congregating.
- Enter the playing area as indicated on the signage.
- Do not congregate in the hallway outside the locker rooms unless writing down scores and then exit promptly.
- Wear a mask while in the facility. Mask wearing on the courts is at your discretion.

WHEN PLAYING

- Try to stay at least six feet apart from other players. Do not make physical contact with them (such as shaking hands or a high five).
- When playing doubles, coordinate with your partner to maintain physical distancing.
- Avoid touching your face after handling a ball, racquet or other equipment. Wash your hands promptly if you have touched your eyes, nose or mouth.
- Avoid sharing food, drinks or towels.
- Use your racquet/foot to pick up balls and hit them to your opponent. Avoid using your hands to pick up the balls.
- Maintain physical distancing if changing ends of the court.
- Remain apart from other players when taking a break.
- If a ball from another court comes to you, send it back with a kick or with your racquet.

AFTER PLAYING

- Leave the court as soon as reasonably possible.
- Wash your hands thoroughly or use a hand sanitizer after coming off the court.
- Do not use the locker room, showers or changing area.
- No extra-curricular or social activity should take place.
- **All players should leave the facility immediately after play.**
